# **SPOTLIGHT**

Within the last week, I was informed that the New York City television station WRNN is in the process of schedule changes. With this change, the 7:30am time

slot IN SEARCH OF THE LORD'S WAY currently has may no longer be available in the near future. Fortunately, a station in NYC recently contacted SEARCH with available time slots on Sundays. We'll let you know more details about this change as they become available. Once again GOD closes some doors and opens others to



ensure his Gospel message continues to be preached.

Whenever broadcast television stations are added, more cable companies become involved as they carry these stations into rural areas where air signals are impossible due to mountains or other geographic constraints. This in turn increases viewership of the program at no additional charge to SEARCH. As we have stated many times before, if you do not currently get the SEARCH program on your cable system, call or write SEARCH. We will discuss and work with you to provide the program in your city or town.

Wherever I go, I am typically asked, "how did IN SEARCH OF THE LORD'S WAY do financially last year during the shutdown?" My answer is, GOD prepared SEARCH for years to preach the GOSPEL using media, radio and television and that is exactly what so many people turned to during the dark days of the virus. 


