From Script to Broadcast: Part 2 - It Starts With a Script

A Bible, a blank page, and Phil Sanders. For over 50 years, Phil has been a dedicated student of the Bible. This is the foundation for every script that he writes for the program. He reads about problems facing God's people, the church and its function in our culture. Modern society presents many challenges for the Christian in their daily walk and for the body as a whole. These are the kinds of things that come together to form an idea for the program. This is how Phil fills the blank page.

Each script is carefully constructed and researched by Phil and follows a similar pattern. There is a very brief greeting, followed by a 2-3 minute introduction to the topic of the program. Then there is the body of the program (sermon) which allows for approximately 15 minutes of speaking time. Finally, there are some closing thoughts that usually comprise 3 to 4 minutes. The completed script is now ready for the next step in the process, where it will encounter several changes. Join us next month as we follow the script into the pre-production phase.
