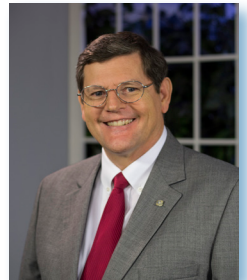

## How Valuable Is Jesus to You?

*"But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ" (Philippians 3:7-8).*

When the apostle Paul was Saul of Tarsus, he had become a rising star among the Jews in Jerusalem. He was "advancing in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries among my countrymen, being more extremely zealous for my ancestral traditions" (Galatians 1:14). ## OCT 3 – IMPOVERISHED IN SPIRIT

# From the *Production Room*

## From Script to Broadcast: Part 3 - What Time is it?

Last month, we learned about the study and research that goes into the creation of the script. Now we’ll take a look at just how the script gets ready for production. As we mentioned last month, the script is in several sections. An introduction, the body, and a short conclusion. Because we know the target length of the program, we can count backward from the end to get our timing correct. So we start with the conclusion and an ending target time of 27 minutes and 30 seconds. Counting lines from the bottom of the page, which has been formatted with specific margins and spacing, time cues and camera changes are inserted into the script in 15 second intervals. The total time is then subtracted from our end time which lets the director know what the target time is for the end of the sermon segment. We’ll continue to count backward through the body (sermon) portion of the script and add time cues and camera changes in one minute intervals all the way to the beginning of that segment. Well, that’s a lot of math, and it can be a little bit confusing. Now that the script is timed it is ready to be loaded into the teleprompter.

Next month, we’ll spend some more time in the pre-production phase and look at some of the setup involved before production can begin.
