The Origin of Life Romans 1:18-23

Dr. Jeff Miller's new book, Science Vs. Evolution, explores how science far short of
being able to the origin of life. The Bible says in Hebrews 11:3, "By we
understand the universe was by the word of God, so that what is seen was not
made out of the things that are visible." Some think that because we as Christians have faith that
we've stopped and have no evidence for our faith; but there is an abundance of
evidence for believing in God. The starry heavens above, the complexity of our bodies, and the
moral lives that live within, proclaim loudly that God us and designed us in His
We are more than who evolved; we are God's creation.
Dr. Miller's book, uses the laws of science themselves to show that evolution's description of
the origin of life is more speculation than science. He reveals that no scientist actually
how life came to be and that to be alive is much more complicated organically than
most folks realize. Dr. Miller says no scientist has ever life from non-living matter,
though they have tried often.
Our reading today comes from the book of Romans 1:18-23.
Many evolutionists that naturalism has been proven to be true. Naturalism is the idea
that everything in existence in the Universe came about naturally—without any from
God, who isn't natural, but supernatural. Cosmic evolution—which is made up of Darwinian
evolution, plus some form of the Big Bang Theory—is how they the Universe got
here. Those who don't evolution are, in the words of the atheist proponent of
evolution Richard Dawkins, "ignorant, stupid, or insane." According to naturalists, due to the
discoveries in science over the past century or so, God is no longer in the
equation to explain the origin of the Universe. They think they've figured out how it all
happened Him, and if you continue to believe in Him, then you are considered
ignorant and unenlightened.
Based on modern definitions of science, God has been from the science classroom.
According to the National Academy of Sciences (the NAS), "The statements of science must
invoke natural things and processes. The statements of science are those that emerge
from the application of intelligence to data obtained from observation and
experiment." Based on this of science, God is unscientific, since He's not
natural, but supernatural, and can't be observed or experimented on.

There are many issues with these claims, but the one significant is that in order for
something to be, it has to have that proves it. If a person arrives at
conclusion that's the evidence, he's being irrational. If a person t
believe in God or the Bible without evidence, he is being irrational. The same goes for a perso
who claims to that naturalism is true. Philosophy doesn't support the idea of
naturalism; science doesn't support such a claim; and neither does The Bible says, "bu

naturalism or atheism is based on several fundamental requirements that have absolutely

going to explore the great hope that we have in Christ. The Lord gave us His so that
we might have hope. He gives us the so that we might put our hope in the truth
and not be fooled by half-truths or lies. You can't separate hope from the truth, any more than
you can separate from the truth. False hope cannot your soul and assure
you of eternal life. That's why we need to the truth of God's Word and to believe
and obey it. This is why from week to week we can't be satisfied with anything less than the
of God's Word.
Romans 15:4 says, "For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our, that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we
might have hope." When I consider how morally this world is, I remember Noah
was righteous and saved his family. When I have a giant, I remember David
defeated Goliath. When I think I'm, I remember that God told Elijah seven
thousand had not bowed the knee to Baal. When I hear "people can't," I recall
Nineveh and how they repented at the preaching of Jonah. When I think things can't get
, I remember the book of Job had an ending. When I walk through a, I
remember Psalm 23 and the Lord is "with me." When I wonder why I'm here, I remember
Joseph; and God had a for his life. I remember Moses both as a baby and as a
shepherd; and God had a plan for him. God also has a plan for you and me.
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Our reading today comes from Psalm 33:18-22.
Let's examine the word "hope." Hope is the confident expectation or belief in the fulfillment
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His blessing. We can hope in our calling as Christians and confidently to live forever, because our Father in heaven raised Jesus from the dead.
First Timothy 1:1 says, "Christ Jesus is our hope." In 1 Corinthians chapter 15 Paul speaks of some who were the resurrection. Paul explained in verses 17 and 18, "if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is; you're still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have" Without the hope of Christ in the resurrection, we will perish in our sins and have no hope of life beyond the Peter urges us, "Therefore, gird your minds for, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought about to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 1:13). Let being with the Lord and the Father in heaven your heart each day. Let hope you to live as a Christian should live.
Read what the apostle John declared in 1 John 3:1-3. Hope for heaven and eternal life leads us to put away and to the Lord in holiness. If you hope for, are you letting sin grow in your life? Purify yourself; get right with God.
When life becomes difficult and painful, we hope. Jeremiah is known as the weeping prophet. First, though Jeremiah watched the destruction of Jerusalem, his relationship with the remained unchanged. He said his peace and his strength had perished; he felt so hopeless; and he had forgotten happiness. It was at this low point in his life, that he the love and the mercy of God.
