#### Loving God James 4:7-10

Longer passages are not quoted in the study sheet, but they can be read in the accompanying transcript.

Of all the tasks of mankind, nothing is more \_\_\_\_\_\_ than loving God. Today we're going to \_\_\_\_\_\_ the subject of loving God. The Scriptures teach us how much God \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ for us, but they also challenge us to love God to give Him our hearts. Christianity is first and foremost a relationship through Christ with our Father in heaven who hears our \_\_\_\_\_\_ and meets our \_\_\_\_\_\_. Without the love of God, this world would indeed be a \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ place. The brightest things in \_\_\_\_\_\_ come because of the love of God. The Bible helps us to \_\_\_\_\_\_ what love is and how love matters in life. That's why we turn to God's \_\_\_\_\_\_ for understanding and guidance.

Imagine you've awakened in a world \_\_\_\_\_\_ love. It's a world where \_\_\_\_\_\_ don't care \_\_\_\_ and they don't care that they don't care. It's a world where offenses begin \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_\_, because there is so little tolerance. It's a world where people are \_\_\_\_\_\_ ambitious, stepping on others and climbing to the top, abusing others merely to survive. It's a world where the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of old people and the unborn are cheap, where \_\_\_\_\_\_ are nothing as long as you get what you \_\_\_\_\_\_. It's a world where people hardly \_\_\_\_\_\_, and those that do rarely stay that way. It's a world where \_\_\_\_\_\_ fend for themselves. It's a world where people sit silent when \_\_\_\_\_\_ takes place, where protecting the weak is unimportant. A world without love would be a world without \_\_\_\_\_\_ and filled with all the ugly substitutions that people find to take love's place. Part of what makes hell so terrible is that you can't \_\_\_\_\_\_ any love there.

#### Our reading today comes from James 4:7-10.

First John 4:19 simply says, "We love because he \_\_\_\_\_ loved us." Among our greatest \_\_\_\_\_, none surpasses the love of God for us. We \_\_\_\_\_ love through knowing God. **Read 1 John 4:7-9**.

We often like to \_\_\_\_\_\_ about how God loves us, but this month we're focusing on how we should love God. We're not focusing on how we want to love God, but on how God \_\_\_\_\_\_ to be loved. Loving God means learning how to \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. We want to please God, so it's important for us to take our \_\_\_\_\_\_ off other things and focus on Him. That's not as easy as it sounds, since there are so many things competing for our \_\_\_\_\_\_. We must be careful not to \_\_\_\_\_\_ away from God.

We choose what we love, and many things \_\_\_\_\_\_ for our affections. The Lord Jesus said, "No one can serve \_\_\_\_\_ masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will

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be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot \_\_\_\_\_ God and money (or mammon)" (Matthew 6:24). What's true of money is true of many things; at some point we must \_\_\_\_\_ whether we will serve God or not.

**Read 1 John 2:15-17**. We can't hold onto worldly \_\_\_\_\_\_ and hold onto Christ at the same time. We must \_\_\_\_\_\_ between the two. We must decide whether we will take our \_\_\_\_\_\_ seriously and truly devote ourselves to God.

Read the prediction the apostle Paul, guided by the Holy Spirit, made in 2 Timothy 3:1-5. This passage speaks of mankind at its \_\_\_\_\_\_, people who pretend godliness but have no \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord or anyone else in their lives. When the choice is made, they're going to do what they \_\_\_\_\_\_. They cannot \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Lord Jesus and say, "not My will but Yours be done," because they love themselves.

They are lovers of \_\_\_\_\_. They want the \_\_\_\_\_\_ that money gives them. **Read 1 Timothy 6:9-10; five observations will follow, based on this passage**. Some who blame God
for their \_\_\_\_\_\_ ought instead to look in the mirror, for they bring many of their
\_\_\_\_\_\_ on themselves. People who will do anything to get rich often find themselves
\_\_\_\_\_\_ with heartaches and regrets.

The passage says, they are "lovers of \_\_\_\_\_\_ rather than lovers of God." They think \_\_\_\_\_ makes them happy, but sin always \_\_\_\_\_\_. Sometimes I hear people justify their sins with "God \_\_\_\_\_ me to be happy!" Yes, God wants to \_\_\_\_\_ us; but God doesn't bless people by blessing their sins. God's blessing comes from righteous \_\_\_\_\_\_, not from following fleshly desires. Peter warns us to "abstain from fleshly \_\_\_\_\_\_ which wage war against the soul" (1 Peter 2:11). Sinful lust enslaves us and hardens our hearts; it robs us of true \_\_\_\_\_\_, and true peace, and love. It never \_\_\_\_\_\_. "The world is \_\_\_\_\_\_ away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives \_\_\_\_\_\_" (1 John 2:17).

People in the last days will fall into the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of "not loving good." They no longer want to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_; they don't want anyone else to be, and they don't want to even hear about it. They're so given to sin, they can no longer \_\_\_\_\_\_ righteousness. The Lord Jesus said, "And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people \_\_\_\_\_\_ the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil" (John 3:19). Some today know \_\_\_\_\_\_ about zombies, and vampires, and witches than they do about the apostles. Their hearts are \_\_\_\_\_\_ away from God.

When people fail to understand the love of God, they eventually \_\_\_\_\_\_ heartless and unloving. They cease to care even for their own \_\_\_\_\_. They have \_\_\_\_\_\_ their hearts. The Lord Jesus predicted, "And because lawlessness is \_\_\_\_\_\_, most people's love will grow cold" (Matthew 24:12). For this reason, they \_\_\_\_\_\_ unappeasable or

irreconcilable. You can't satisfy them or make friends with them, because they are so given to \_\_\_\_\_\_. People begin losing their love for God when they stop \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ their blessings. They become ungrateful, as if the world \_\_\_\_\_\_ them whatever they have. They cannot be \_\_\_\_\_\_ with what they have and appreciate it, because they \_\_\_\_\_ what others have.

What can we do to \_\_\_\_\_\_ our love to God while we're surrounded by a sinful and secular world? **Read the answer in James 4:7-10**. First, we must \_\_\_\_\_\_ ourselves to God. We must choose to make the Lord Jesus the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of our hearts. To do that, we must take \_\_\_\_\_\_ off the throne. **Read Romans 6:16-18**. No matter what our past has been, we can \_\_\_\_\_\_ God from our hearts and make changes to our lives. Submitting to God isn't \_\_\_\_\_\_; submitting to God \_\_\_\_\_\_ us from the sin that ruins us. God gives us \_\_\_\_\_\_!

Second, we must \_\_\_\_\_\_ the devil. The passage says if we resist the devil, he will \_\_\_\_\_\_ from us. The devil is \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, but he is not stronger than the Lord Jesus. **Read 1**John 3:7-8. Jesus triumphed over the devil when He bore the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to forgive sin and rose
from the dead to overcome death. Christians can gladly \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus, for "he who is in you
(that is the Lord in you) is \_\_\_\_\_\_ than he who is in the world" (1 John 4:4).

Many find it \_\_\_\_\_\_ to flirt with the devil and play with sin; but we can't get close to God while we're flirting with the devil. We must get away from the devil in order to \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God. We have to \_\_\_\_\_\_ we won't run with the devil any more, and we won't run with his crowd any more. We have to decide we're not going to play his \_\_\_\_\_\_, and we're not going to do his bidding. When we finally get the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to resist the devil and tell him to get lost, we'll see the devil flee. He won't \_\_\_\_\_\_ to be around us! He knows he cannot \_\_\_\_\_\_ when we have the Lord on our side. We must decide to resist; and with the help of God we'll overcome.

Third, we need to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to God, and when we draw near to God, He will draw near to us. The Father in heaven and the Lord Jesus want to be \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to you and to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ you. Jesus died on the cross to demonstrate His \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ for you. The Lord Jesus said, "I tell you, there will be more \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance" (Luke 15:7). God's heart is \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to you, pleading for you to return to Him and to serve Him. **Read Isaiah 55:6-7**.

Fourth, the passage says \_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_, you sinners. We must make a clean \_\_\_\_\_ with sin. We've got to \_\_\_\_\_. We can't draw close to God while we \_\_\_\_\_ on to our sins. **Read Isaiah 59:1-2**. Sin \_\_\_\_\_ you from God, so get rid of the sin and draw close to God. When Adam and Eve realized they had sinned and were naked, they hid in the bushes, and they were \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of God. Sin fills us with \_\_\_\_\_\_

and \_\_\_\_\_\_. Repentance \_\_\_\_\_\_ the heart, and it opens the door to forgiveness, and it sets a person in a new direction that allows fellowship with God and how it can be restored.

Fifth, purify your \_\_\_\_\_\_, you double-minded. We \_\_\_\_\_\_ a clean heart and a clean conscience. This demands coming clean with God, confessing our \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Him. Proverbs 28:13 says, "He who conceals his transgressions will not \_\_\_\_\_\_, But he who confesses and forsakes them will \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ compassion." Likewise 1 John 1:8-9 says, "If we say that we have \_\_\_\_\_\_ sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we \_\_\_\_\_\_ our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." As long as we have issues with God we'll find it \_\_\_\_\_\_ to draw close to Him. God loves you. Being right with God opens up that door to eternal life and the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of God that He gives forever. Remaining in sin will only \_\_\_\_\_\_ you heartache and ruin. Love the Lord! Love God! Love Him \_\_\_\_\_\_ He first loved you. Don't let \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ come between you and God – not sin, not money, not pleasure, not your own \_\_\_\_\_\_. The more you love God the more \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_\_ you'll find. Get right with God!

Draw near to \_\_\_\_\_\_, and He will draw near to \_\_\_\_\_\_. Have you entangled your life in other things and drifted away from Him, or is your heart \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God? God calls us to open our \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Him. The Lord Jesus told lukewarm Laodicea, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; and if anyone \_\_\_\_\_\_ My voice and \_\_\_\_\_\_ the door, I will come in to him, and will dine with him, and he will dine with Me" (Revelation 3:20). The Lord wants a \_\_\_\_\_\_ friendship with us. There's a famous painting showing Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ at a door. In the painting, the door has no handle on the \_\_\_\_\_\_; the door can only be opened from the \_\_\_\_\_\_. He knocks, but He won't \_\_\_\_\_\_ the door. He knocks, but you must \_\_\_\_\_\_ your door and your heart to let Him in.

Love calls for a \_\_\_\_\_\_. It's not enough to be loved by God; we must love in \_\_\_\_\_\_. Jesus said, "If you love Me, you will \_\_\_\_\_\_ My commandments" (John 14:15). Love doesn't argue; it \_\_\_\_\_\_ by trusting and obeying. The gospel is the good news of God's love and Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_\_. So don't be ungrateful for that love; \_\_\_\_\_\_ by trusting and obeying the Lord. If you know and love the Lord, you'll have no \_\_\_\_\_\_ trusting Him or His teaching.

If you love Jesus, you can't remain in sin, which \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. Love leads us to \_\_\_\_\_\_ sin behind. Love means telling the world that you belong to Him, \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him to be the Christ, the Son of God, and being \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ into Christ. Galatians 3:26-27 says, "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ." Baptism is the time when God \_\_\_\_\_\_ away our sins (Acts 22:16) and saves us (1 Peter 3:21). So, open your heart to the Lord! Love and obey!





#### Loving God Totally Mark 12:28-31

Longer passages are not quoted in the study sheet, but they can be read in the accompanying transcript.

Can you truthfully say that you totally \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord? Today we're going to explore what it means to \_\_\_\_\_\_ all to the Lord. The Bible \_\_\_\_\_\_ God's love for us and the kind of love He \_\_\_\_\_\_ from us. God doesn't want part-time \_\_\_\_\_\_ or people who are only fond of Him. God expects His people to be totally committed to Him and to His \_\_\_\_\_\_. The Lord did not show us a half-hearted love, but gave everything so that we might be \_\_\_\_\_\_. It shouldn't surprise anyone that He \_\_\_\_\_\_ that we surrender all to Him.

The apostle Paul said, "But far be it from me to boast except in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world" (Galatians 6:14). Paul knew the Christian life is the noblest and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ life, but living for Christ is challenging in a world that doesn't understand or appreciate devotion. Paul said, "I have been crucified with Christ. It's no longer I who live, but \_\_\_\_\_\_ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me" (Galatians 2:20). Our \_\_\_\_\_\_ today is to live by faith in Christ. When we are crucified with Him, we no longer belong to \_\_\_\_\_\_; we belong to Him.

Christianity is more than a \_\_\_\_\_\_ to wear; it's a life. Because we belong to the Lord, we surrender every \_\_\_\_\_\_, every \_\_\_\_\_, and every \_\_\_\_\_ to the will of God. Like Christ, we pray, "Thy \_\_\_\_\_ be done on earth as it is in heaven" and "not my \_\_\_\_\_ but Yours be done." Do you love God totally?

#### Our reading today comes from The Gospel According To Mark 12:28-31.

What did Paul \_\_\_\_\_\_ when he said he was crucified with Christ? He wasn't at Calvary; he didn't \_\_\_\_\_\_ on a cross. Paul isn't speaking of a \_\_\_\_\_\_ cross and nails. He's speaking figuratively. Crucifixion was a means of \_\_\_\_\_\_. It was cruel, slow and painful, designed to make the person \_\_\_\_\_\_ as long as possible. Crucifixions, in ancient times, publicly \_\_\_\_\_\_ the criminal to keep others from committing a crime. Our crucifixion with Christ is a \_\_\_\_\_\_ identification with Him. We are \_\_\_\_\_\_ with Him in His death, burial and resurrection when we are baptized according to Romans 6:4-7. We are crucified with Christ in order to put to death the old self of \_\_\_\_\_\_ and to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ again. We can't have \_\_\_\_\_\_ of life until the old man of sin is dead. When we're baptized into Christ, He begins \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in us. In being crucified with Him, we take a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ with Christ for truth and for morality. We say to the sinful and worldly things "So far as you're concerned world, I'm \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to you and May be reproduced in its entirety for purposes of classroom material or personal study.

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you're \_\_\_\_\_ to me. You have no more \_\_\_\_\_\_ over me than you have over a dead body." Paul said, "those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the \_\_\_\_\_\_ with its passions and desires" (Galatians 5:24). This is a thorough, lifelong, and \_\_\_\_\_\_ commitment. When we come to Christ there is \_\_\_\_\_ turning back.

Since we belong to Christ, we can say with Paul, "So then, brothers, we are \_\_\_\_\_, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will \_\_\_\_\_, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will \_\_\_\_\_" (Romans 8:12-13). Our eternal \_\_\_\_\_\_ is dependent on whether we choose to live for the Lord or we choose the flesh. We choose to \_\_\_\_\_\_ Christ by coming to Him and loving what is good.

We want to \_\_\_\_\_ God. **Read Romans 6:8-11**. Christians are \_\_\_\_\_ to give up that old way of life so they can \_\_\_\_\_ their love for Christ.

When we're crucified with Christ, we \_\_\_\_\_ our behavior and our thinking. This change gets specific. For instance, Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ were crucified. They crossed His feet upon the upright beam of the cross and drove the long \_\_\_\_\_ into them. That driven nail \_\_\_\_\_ through His flesh. We can only imagine the \_\_\_\_\_. Our feet should be crucified, too. What do we \_\_\_\_\_ by "crucified feet?" We must \_\_\_\_\_ where our feet take us and never let them lead us into a place that will dishonor Christ. Peter said, "For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an \_\_\_\_\_, so that you might follow in his steps" (1 Peter 2:21). Being "crucified with Christ" means we give Him \_\_\_\_\_ in our lives. Because our feet \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Him, we go wherever He \_\_\_\_\_\_ us. God had a \_\_\_\_\_\_ for Isaiah to do. Isaiah 6:8 says, "Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, 'Whom shall I \_\_\_\_\_, and who will go for Us?' Then I said, 'Here am \_\_\_. Send \_\_\_\_!'" We need that "Here am I; send me" \_\_\_\_\_. Some people \_\_\_\_\_ their lives foolishly and selfishly. They never give a thought to how they may \_\_\_\_\_ anybody else. The greatest thing that anyone can do is to take the saving \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel to people who are lost. Remember what Jesus said in Mark 16:15-16. There are people lost and dying in \_\_\_\_\_ because no one ever \_\_\_\_\_\_ them about Jesus. Will you tell your friends about Jesus?

They not only nailed His feet; Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ were also crucified. They \_\_\_\_\_ his hands down. Our hands are crucified, too. They are not nailed down, but we must not \_\_\_\_\_ them any way we wish. We must be \_\_\_\_\_\_ what we handle. They should never handle anything that will \_\_\_\_\_\_ them with sin or wrong. The hands of Jesus were laid upon suffering human beings to \_\_\_\_\_\_ them, but can you imagine Jesus holding anything sinful in those hands? Be careful what you \_\_\_\_\_\_. Paul said, "Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up \_\_\_\_\_\_ hands, without wrath and dissension" (1 Timothy 2:8). People in the early church lifted their hands up to God when they \_\_\_\_\_\_. They were wanting God to know that they \_\_\_\_\_\_\_.

Him as they approached Him. But Paul was telling them that when we \_\_\_\_\_\_ God, we need to pray to Him with holy hands, not just lifting hands. Don't lift your hands up to God if you are full of \_\_\_\_\_\_ at your brother or you're fussing with him. God has never accepted \_\_\_\_\_\_ from people who have sin in their \_\_\_\_\_\_. Read what Isaiah wrote by inspiration in Isaiah 1:15-17. God wants our lives \_\_\_\_\_\_ with holiness when we worship Him. When we choose to follow Christ, we can't \_\_\_\_\_\_ whether we will treat people kindly or whether we will live a moral life. We must take hold of God's will in \_\_\_\_\_\_ aspect of our lives. We can't pick and choose when we will \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Lord and when we won't. When we say \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God, we are rebelling against Him. It's at that very point where we \_\_\_\_\_\_ God; we are withholding our love and obedience from Him. We must give our \_\_\_\_\_\_ selves \_\_\_\_\_ body, soul, and spirit – to the Lord. Use your hands for good and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ the Lord. Paul said, "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith" (Galatians 6:10). We serve the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ by doing good for

This may at first sound silly to you, but you know a Christian should crucify his \_\_\_\_\_\_ – not in the literal sense. He should put to death or give up whatever he \_\_\_\_\_\_ that might keep him from serving Christ. If our ears are crucified, we'll be careful about what we \_\_\_\_\_\_ to. There are voices all about us and some voices will \_\_\_\_\_\_ us to sin. If we belong to \_\_\_\_\_\_, we won't listen to them. **Read how Jesus called himself the good shepherd in John 10:3-5**. Some of these strange voices say, "Don't go to \_\_\_\_\_\_ to worship. Why you've been \_\_\_\_\_\_ all week. Have a good time \_\_\_\_\_\_ of going to church." That's the \_\_\_\_\_\_ talking. Some say, "Put yourself \_\_\_\_\_\_ Indulge in whatever \_\_\_\_\_\_ you. Make more \_\_\_\_\_\_. Forget what the \_\_\_\_\_\_ says. You must look out for \_\_\_\_\_\_." The devil is always interested in \_\_\_\_\_\_ us from Christ and from the will of God. Crucified ears won't \_\_\_\_\_\_ to such compromise. Other times people say, "It doesn't matter what you \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ as long as you \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus." If you really love Jesus, you'll \_\_\_\_\_\_ what He has to say, and you'll distinguish His words from the words of men. Jesus said, "Everyone who is of the truth \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to my voice" (John 18:37).

Because what we say \_\_\_\_\_\_, we need to put to death any speech that does not follow the will of God. James said the tongue is uncontrollable and cannot be \_\_\_\_\_\_. If we use our tongues for Jesus, we will speak \_\_\_\_\_\_. We won't \_\_\_\_\_\_ and we won't \_\_\_\_\_\_ the gossip we hear from other people. Solomon said, "He who goes about as a slanderer \_\_\_\_\_\_ secrets, Therefore do not associate with a gossip" (Proverbs 20:19). Again Proverbs 10:11 says, "The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of \_\_\_\_\_\_, But the mouth of the wicked conceals violence." Peter said, "The one who desires life, to love and see good days, Must \_\_\_\_\_\_ his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit" (1 Peter 3:10). Some people delight in

\_\_\_\_\_\_ others with their words. They criticize or falsely label, and their words \_\_\_\_\_\_. Our \_\_\_\_\_\_ should be soothing and not cutting. Colossians 4:6 says, "Let your speech always be with \_\_\_\_\_\_, *as though* seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person."

Along with our hands, our feet, our ears, and our tongues, we must also put to death the things in our \_\_\_\_\_\_ that offend God. The old man of sin in our hearts must be crucified so that we can \_\_\_\_\_ a new life filled with love for God. Jesus' heart felt the full \_\_\_\_\_ of his crucifixion. He came to His own and His own \_\_\_\_\_ Him not. The sin of the \_\_\_\_\_ was upon Him. God, the Father, for a time \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. As He died they thrust the \_\_\_\_\_ into His side, and water and blood gushed out. His \_\_\_\_\_ was devastated by crucifixion. Is your heart crucified? Is it \_\_\_\_\_ to sin and evil? Is it a \_\_\_\_\_ upon which Jesus lives? Does He have \_\_\_\_\_ place in your life, or is your heart \_\_\_\_\_ between the world and Jesus? Read James 4:4. Are you like that? Do you give \_\_\_\_\_ of yourself to Christ and \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ the other part? Do you hang onto the world and its \_\_\_\_\_\_ with one hand, and hang on to God with the other? Remember God sees what we are doing. We can't serve God and \_\_\_\_\_ or God and \_\_\_\_\_. We can't serve God and \_\_\_\_\_. We can't serve God and \_\_\_\_. If we are crucified with Christ, our \_\_\_\_\_ heart belongs to Him. That means our whole \_\_\_\_\_ belongs to Him too. Read what Paul said in 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. When you become a Christian, God becomes your \_\_\_\_\_; and you belong to Him. Do you belong body, soul, and spirit to God? When you were baptized, they immersed \_\_\_\_\_ of you. When you love the Lord and die to self, you should be ready to take up your \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.

How do we die to self and take up our cross? Romans 6:4-7 tells us, "We were buried therefore with him by \_\_\_\_\_\_ into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have become united with him in a \_\_\_\_\_\_ like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to \_\_\_\_\_. For one who has died has been set free from sin."

Do you \_\_\_\_\_\_in Christ? Have you \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_\_ the name of Christ before others? Have you been \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ into Christ? When you do so, you'll receive the forgiveness of sins, and you'll be \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord's church, and you'll become a \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God. When you die and are buried with Christ in baptism, that old man of sin is crucified, and you start walking in \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of life. You are \_\_\_\_\_\_; you can enter the kingdom. Put your trust in Jesus and obey the gospel. Die to yourself and take up your cross today and live for the Lord from this day forward.



#### STUDY SHEPT April 20, 2014

#### Love and Law Mark 3:31-35

Longer passages are not quoted in the study sheet, but they can be read in the accompanying transcript.

Can love and law \_\_\_\_\_? Can people \_\_\_\_\_ God's law lovingly? Today we're going to see how loving God and keeping His laws can work \_\_\_\_\_\_. The psalmist said, "Open my \_\_\_\_\_\_, that I may behold Wonderful things from Your law" (Psalm 119:18). We too need to open our eyes and our \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the law of God that we may behold wonderful things. Verse 24 says, "Your testimonies also are my \_\_\_\_\_\_; They are my counselors." When we take time to read and meditate on Scripture, we find wisdom and counsel that \_\_\_\_\_\_ us. No wonder this psalmist cried out in verse 97, "O how I \_\_\_\_\_ Your law! It's my meditation all the day." Is the Bible your delight and your meditation?

Read what the Lord Jesus said to the Pharisees when they followed their traditions and ignored God's law in Matthew 15:7-9. The problem with the Pharisees and with many Christians is that by making human traditions they lose \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God. Their hearts are so concerned with themselves that they have no \_\_\_\_\_\_ for God. People who focus on the instructions God gave us, however, are \_\_\_\_\_\_ their love and respect for Him. God gave us His laws to show His love for us and to \_\_\_\_\_\_ us. The law of God isn't a burden or grievous; it is God's \_\_\_\_\_\_ of telling us what is evil and harmful. Love and law can coexist!

#### Our reading today comes from the Gospel According To Mark 3:31-35.

The Lord Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ that by keeping the Lord's commandments, we show our love for Him and for the Father. The Lord said, "If you \_\_\_\_\_ Me, you will \_\_\_\_\_ My commandments" (John 14:15). That seems so \_\_\_\_\_\_, and yet our society questions what the Lord says. People try to distance the \_\_\_\_\_ to obey from love. They think if someone keeps a commandment, they are merely observing a meaningless \_\_\_\_\_\_ or trying to \_\_\_\_\_ salvation. It seems they may not understand obedience the \_\_\_\_\_\_ that the Lord Jesus understands it. Jesus understands obedience as a means of \_\_\_\_\_\_.

**Read what the Lord said in John 14:23-24**. The Father and the Lord Jesus make their \_\_\_\_\_\_ with those that they love, and they love the people who love them enough to keep their words. Love \_\_\_\_\_\_ enough to obey. When people \_\_\_\_\_\_ to keep those words, they show that they don't love the Lord. These words aren't merely the words of Jesus; they belong to the \_\_\_\_\_\_. **Remember today's reading in Mark 3:33-35**.

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The Lord Jesus also sets the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for us in how to love the Father. **Read what Jesus** said in John 15:8-10. We must \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Lord's example and \_\_\_\_\_\_ our discipleship by keeping the Father's commandments.

Authentic Christianity, real Christianity, authentic obedience, real obedience is always motivated by the \_\_\_\_\_, by the love that we have for the Lord Jesus Christ. We can't \_\_\_\_\_ that simply because someone obeys and insists on obedience that he is legalistic or a Pharisee. **Read what the apostle Paul said in 2 Corinthians 5:14-15**. The love of Christ motivated \_\_\_\_\_ to live for Jesus. There are no \_\_\_\_\_ or self-serving motives here, but \_\_\_\_\_ and authentic love for Christ. That is what God \_\_\_\_\_ – love that keeps God's commandments, His laws.

**Read 1 John 2:3-6**. To know the Lord in this passage means to have a \_\_\_\_\_, loving relationship with Him. That relationship is determined by \_\_\_\_\_\_ commandments. Complete love for God means one is devoted to keeping the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord.

For the \_\_\_\_\_\_ or nominal Christian, keeping commandments is burdensome; it's a drudgery; but the authentic Christian \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in keeping God's commandments. **Read 1 John 5:2-3**. True Christians find delight in God's commandments, because they know that every commandment of God is for our \_\_\_\_\_\_ and our \_\_\_\_\_\_. They realize that the words of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ to eternal life and to living abundantly.

Some say that a law of Christ doesn't \_\_\_\_\_\_, but the Scriptures speak differently. They've read some passages which speak a truth, but it doesn't give the \_\_\_\_\_\_ truth. For instance, they might cite Romans 3:28, where Paul says, "For we maintain that a man is justified by \_\_\_\_\_\_ apart from works of the Law." They might cite Galatians 2:21, where Paul says, "I do not nullify the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly." But the context of both of these passages is speaking of the Law of God given by \_\_\_\_\_\_. The Law of Moses surely does not \_\_\_\_\_\_ anyone today under Christ. We should not \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Law of Moses with the commandments found in the New Testament that come from Jesus our Lord. **Read what other people cite in Ephesians 2:8-10**. Truly we cannot \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ our way to heaven, you can't and I can't. No one can say that we've done so well that God \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ us salvation. We shouldn't, however, confuse \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to Christ with some effort that earns salvation apart from the grace of God. We do not earn our salvation, but we must \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to grace. Faith and obedience are \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to receive the gift.

Let's say that I have placed a treasure worth millions of dollars in your back yard, and I tell you about it. I say, all you have to do is to go out there and dig it up, and you have to go to that exact location where I placed it. If you fail to dig or you dig in the wrong place, you won't

enjoy the great gift. You must \_\_\_\_\_\_ directions to enjoy the blessing. Who would imagine that because you did a little digging that you earned that treasure? Why, you didn't earn the treasure; you simply met the conditions of the gift. So it is with obedience and God; obedience is the proper \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the gift so that one may enjoy eternal life. Our salvation is a treasure beyond our ability to pay, and no one can work hard enough in a lifetime to earn an eternity with God; but if we \_\_\_\_\_\_ to follow the Lord, we won't be able to enjoy His blessing.

Obedience is a \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the grace of God, not some work of merit that earns us salvation. While the grace of God is unmerited and undeserved, it's by no means \_\_\_\_\_\_. While God offers His grace to every man, not everyone \_\_\_\_\_\_ that gift. Many choose to serve the world and they lose sight of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus paid to save us.

The Scriptures do indeed speak of the law of Christ, and God expects faithful Christians to \_\_\_\_\_ Christ's law. Listen to the inspired word of God. **Read what Paul said in 1 Corinthians 9:19-21**. Paul was \_\_\_\_\_\_ the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2 says, "Bear one another's burdens, and thereby \_\_\_\_\_\_ the law of Christ."

Like Paul, James also \_\_\_\_\_\_ that Christians are under a law. **Read James 2:10-12**. Yes, the law of Christ is a law of \_\_\_\_\_.

Obedience to the Lord is not an \_\_\_\_\_\_; it's a necessity to please God. John 3:36 says, "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him." When people \_\_\_\_\_\_ to do as God instructs they cannot expect to have eternal life. Instead, they can expect to face the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God. Everything that is in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ points to faith and obedience. Paul said that he "received grace and apostleship to bring about the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the sake of his name (that is the name of Christ) among all the nations" (Romans 1:5). He wanted people not only to \_\_\_\_\_\_ but also to \_\_\_\_\_\_. In fact, the apostle Paul, in the book of Romans, tells how a slave of sin is \_\_\_\_\_\_ from that sin and becomes a slave of righteousness. Our transformation into children of God is not by faith alone but includes our \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. Romans 6:17-18 says, "But thanks be to God that though you were committed, and having been \_\_\_\_\_\_ from that sin, when they became obedient from their \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to His teaching. If you believe the gospel, you will \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ the gospel. Your \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ comes when you become obedient!

The apostle Paul wrote, "and to give relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who \_\_\_\_\_ the gospel of our

Lord Jesus. These will pay the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power" (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).

Jesus sets the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of obedience for us. Jesus obeyed the Father so that we can be \_\_\_\_\_\_. Hebrews 5:8-9 says, "Although He was a Son, He \_\_\_\_\_\_ obedience from the things which He suffered. And having been made perfect, He became to all those who \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him the source of eternal salvation." Jesus wasn't a legalist or a Pharisee; He was obedient because He \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Father. In fact, Jesus said, "but so that the world may know that I love the Father, I do \_\_\_\_\_\_ as the Father commanded Me" (John 14:31). He did just as the Father \_\_\_\_\_\_ from them. He \_\_\_\_\_\_ did exactly what the Father told Him to do. Doing things carefully and precisely as we're \_\_\_\_\_\_ shows conscientiousness, carefulness and love. It means we take the Lord seriously and lovingly, just as Jesus did His Father.

Why does keeping the law of Christ matter? Because if we \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus, we'll \_\_\_\_\_ His commandments. We too can say, "but so that the \_\_\_\_\_\_ may know that we love the Father, we do exactly as the Father commands us." Do you love the Father? Are you keeping His commandments? If you choose not to \_\_\_\_\_\_ in Christ, you cannot be saved. The Lord said, "Go into all the world and \_\_\_\_\_\_ the gospel to all creation. He who has believed and has been baptized shall be \_\_\_\_\_\_; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned" (Mark 16:15-16). If you love the Lord, you'll trust in Him and believe the \_\_\_\_\_. You can't refuse to believe and be saved. That's His teaching.

If you choose not to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of your sins, you cannot be saved. The Lord said, "unless you repent, you will all likewise \_\_\_\_\_\_" (Luke 13:3).. If you love the Lord, you'll \_\_\_\_\_\_ your sins (Matthew 5:30). If you aren't willing to repent, you'll perish. That's His teaching.

If you choose not to \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus Christ as the Son of God, you'll be cast aside by Christ. The Lord Jesus said, "Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 10:32-33). That's the Lord's teaching!

If you refuse to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ into Christ, you can't have forgiveness. Acts 2:38 says, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts 22:16 says, "Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized, and \_\_\_\_\_\_ your sins, calling on His name." That's Scripture. If you love God, you won't argue with God; you'll obey His Word. And you'll obey quickly!





#### Do You Love Me John 21:15-17

Longer passages are not quoted in the study sheet, but they can be read in the accompanying transcript.

God loves us, and He \_\_\_\_\_\_ each of us to love Him. Today we're asking the question, "What does love \_\_\_\_\_ me to do?" We know God is gracious and loving; He provides for us every \_\_\_\_\_\_ of life. We're so grateful to God for life and every good thing, that we feel the need to \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Him. The Scriptures \_\_\_\_\_\_ us how God has provided for us and how we should respond to Him. Everyone who gives love wants to be loved in \_\_\_\_\_\_. When Jesus Christ sacrificed Himself upon the \_\_\_\_\_\_, He showed to us an undeniable love. We shouldn't be \_\_\_\_\_\_, then, that the Lord Jesus wants our love and commitment.

I became a Christian \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the love of Jesus. His love, His power, His teaching, His wisdom, His truthfulness, His compassion \_\_\_\_\_\_ my heart and my loyalty. I became a Christian because of the grace and forgiveness Christ \_\_\_\_\_\_. I knew that I needed His \_\_\_\_\_\_. I wanted to go to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and I didn't want to be lost eternally. Jesus Christ bore a cross to demonstrate His love, and He gives \_\_\_\_\_\_ a cross to bear as well. Christianity is a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ commitment to the cause of Christ. The Lord Jesus said, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must \_\_\_\_\_\_ himself, and take up his cross daily and \_\_\_\_\_\_ Me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake, he is the one who will save it. For what is a man \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ if he gains the whole world, and loses or forfeits himself?" (Luke 9:23-25). Have you made a loving commitment to the Lord?

#### Our reading today comes from The Gospel According to John 21:15-17.

Some people today \_\_\_\_\_\_ in a "designer Christianity." They think they can \_\_\_\_\_ their own blend of religion, and God will be satisfied. Some think God ought to be \_\_\_\_\_ with anything that we offer to Him. It's almost as if God \_\_\_\_\_ us and He ought to be happy that we give anything to Him in the way of service or worship. Many \_\_\_\_\_ that God created us; we didn't create Him. They forget that we're dependent upon \_\_\_\_\_, but He's not dependent upon us. They forget that Jesus died for our sins to \_\_\_\_\_\_ us from sin and spiritual death. Christianity isn't something that we design as we like; it's a \_\_\_\_\_\_ faith from God that we should follow. We owe our very soul's \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God. Our soul is \_\_\_\_\_\_ more than the whole world. Let's get serious about our faith.

What do we \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus? First, you and I owe Jesus our \_\_\_\_\_. After Peter denied Jesus three times on the night that Jesus was taken into custody, Jesus later \_\_\_\_\_\_

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Peter. **Read the Bible record of their conversation in John 21:15-17**. The Bible teaches us how we're supposed to \_\_\_\_\_\_ our love for Jesus. The Lord said, "If you love Me, you'll \_\_\_\_\_ My commandments" (John 14:15). I can't \_\_\_\_\_ to love the Lord and \_\_\_\_\_ against the things that Jesus teaches. I can't claim to love the Lord and then make \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the will of God or claim the Lord doesn't teach the \_\_\_\_\_. How I love the Lord is by \_\_\_\_\_\_ to his Word and \_\_\_\_\_\_ it.

If I love the Lord, I'll draw close to Him and I'll \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. I can't claim to love the Lord if I never take \_\_\_\_\_\_ to worship Him. **Read what the Bible says in Hebrews 10:24-**25. How can you say to the Lord that you \_\_\_\_\_\_ love Him if you never worship at church. What does that say to God? You might be pleased with \_\_\_\_\_\_, but is God pleased with you? You can't love God on your own \_\_\_\_\_\_ and never consider what God wants or desires. What kind of love is that?

Our worship must be \_\_\_\_\_\_ and come from our hearts. God knows our hearts. Some people go to religious \_\_\_\_\_\_ and they think they've worshiped because they \_\_\_\_\_\_ something religious coming to them. But no matter how moving a concert is God, wants something \_\_\_\_\_\_ from you. What He wants is your heart, your lips, and your life, not as a spectator but as a \_\_\_\_\_\_. Read what the Lord Jesus said in John 4:23-24. Genuine worship comes from our loving hearts and it \_\_\_\_\_\_ the God of heaven. We must never \_\_\_\_\_\_ religious entertainment with worship. Genuine love \_\_\_\_\_\_ to honor the Lord.

Second, I owe Jesus my \_\_\_\_\_\_. Since I belong to Him, I ought to wear His \_\_\_\_\_\_ and never be ashamed to own Him as my Lord. Colossians 3:17 says, "And whatever you do, in word or deed, do \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." As church members, we're the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ and we ought to wear His name. I don't understand why some \_\_\_\_\_\_ the name of Christ from the church. We're \_\_\_\_\_\_ to wear the name of "Christian" and to be a member of the church that belongs to Jesus Christ. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ the church; He purchased it with his own \_\_\_\_\_\_; and He serves as the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the church, and is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the church. Why wouldn't the church want to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ his name? Why wouldn't a Christian honor Christ in every aspect of his \_\_\_\_\_\_?

The Lord Jesus said, "For whoever is ashamed of Me and of My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes in His glory, and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels" (Luke 9:26). Some folks are simply ashamed to \_\_\_\_\_\_ that they are Christians and that they go to church. They'd rather stay silent than to be ridiculed for their \_\_\_\_\_ by the world. What kind of loyalty is that? The apostle Paul who died for his faith, said, "I have been \_\_\_\_\_\_ with Christ; and it's no longer I who live, but Christ \_\_\_\_\_\_ in me; and the life

which I now live in the flesh I live by \_\_\_\_\_ in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me" (Galatians 2:20). We need that kind of loyalty! Jesus needs to live in our hearts and in our lives.

We can't accept the world's morals and \_\_\_\_\_\_ loyalty to Jesus. Our lives must show our \_\_\_\_\_\_. Read what the Bible says in Ephesians 5:15-17. Unfortunately, some Christians live like they've never \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus or \_\_\_\_\_\_ a Bible. Their mouths are full of ungodly words and their actions show that they don't \_\_\_\_\_\_ about Jesus Christ. First John 2:6 says, "the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk (that is to live) in the same \_\_\_\_\_\_ as Jesus walked (or lived)." If we're to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Christ, then let's live lives worthy of the name of Christ, and really be "Christians."

The Lord Jesus said, "No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he'll be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (or money)" (Matthew 6:24). Some people live to make \_\_\_\_\_\_, and nothing else matters. If you make money your \_\_\_\_\_\_, then Jesus won't be. This is true of anything. You can't serve \_\_\_\_\_\_ masters faithfully. You'll \_\_\_\_\_\_ to follow one and reject the other. If you wear the name of Christ, then \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. Don't let \_\_\_\_\_\_ come between you and the Lord. **Read what the apostle Paul said in 2 Corinthians 5:9-10**. Do you please the Lord Jesus Christ?

Third, I owe Jesus my \_\_\_\_\_\_. Jesus was willing to \_\_\_\_\_\_ everything in order to accomplish the will of His Father. **Read what Jesus said in John 10:17-18**. Jesus willingly laid down His life for our sakes because He received the commandment from His \_\_\_\_\_\_. He didn't \_\_\_\_\_\_ with His Father; He didn't ask to be excused; and He didn't recommend someone else go to the cross. His Father loved Him for it, and the Father loves us when we \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him from a pure and loving heart.

Jesus asks us to obey him by taking up our \_\_\_\_\_\_. Jesus himself knows what it is to sacrifice in order to \_\_\_\_\_\_. Obedience is necessary if we are to \_\_\_\_\_\_ God. Jesus once asked, "Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I \_\_\_\_\_\_ you?" (Luke 6:46). If we \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus as our Savior, we must also recognize Him as our Lord. If we recognize Him as Lord, then we ought to \_\_\_\_\_\_ whatever He commands, \_\_\_\_\_ wherever He sends, and \_\_\_\_\_\_ whatever He asks. Obedience means we \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ our will to His will. We don't \_\_\_\_\_\_ ourselves from our duty; we don't act on our own without God's authority. We don't \_\_\_\_\_\_ with God; we \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. Obedience means I'll follow Christ and keep His teaching regardless of the \_\_\_\_\_\_. I'll follow Jesus because I \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him to save me and to lead me in the right path. I'll follow Jesus even when I don't \_\_\_\_\_\_. I don't know everything; and God sees and knows things I'll never know. I trust God, and I trust my

Lord Jesus. I'll follow Jesus when it's \_\_\_\_\_\_ and I'll follow Jesus when it's \_\_\_\_\_\_. The straight and narrow road may not seem easy, but it's the \_\_\_\_\_\_ road to eternal life. My friends may not go with me; they may even ridicule me for following Jesus, but I won't take any other \_\_\_\_\_\_ than to follow my Lord.

Fourth, I owe Jesus my \_\_\_\_\_\_. Jesus didn't \_\_\_\_\_ His life at the cross; He \_\_\_\_\_\_ it purposefully. He gave His \_\_\_\_\_\_ to a crown of thorns, He gave his \_\_\_\_\_\_ to a terrible scourging, He gave his \_\_\_\_\_\_ to a spear; He gave his hands and feet to the nails; He shed his \_\_\_\_\_\_ for our sins; and He yielded up his spirit to God. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ what it was to give of Himself. The Bible says, "For you know the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich" (2 Corinthians 8:9). Again, 1 Peter 2:24 says, "He himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might \_\_\_\_\_\_ to sin and \_\_\_\_\_\_ to righteousness. For by his \_\_\_\_\_\_ you have been healed." Jesus made a very personal and very costly sacrifice so that we could have forgiveness and eternal life.

Why does all this matter? Because if we \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord, we'll \_\_\_\_\_ our love by our worship, our service, our obedience, and our sacrifice. We'll never stop being \_\_\_\_\_. The Father sacrificed His beloved Son so that we might \_\_\_\_\_. Many never give that a second thought. Do you? I certainly hope you will.

Have you considered the ultimate sacrifice that Christ made on your behalf? Will you \_\_\_\_\_ your life to Him to serve Him? To become a Christian one must put his \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord and be willing to follow His \_\_\_\_\_. People become Christians because they come to know the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God through the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. God raises us up with Christ, and the Lord \_\_\_\_\_\_ us to His church. When we're baptized, God makes us his children and heirs of \_\_\_\_\_\_ life with Christ. We \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ in baptism so that we may \_\_\_\_\_ with him forever. I pray that you will give yourself to Him. I pray you'll put your trust in Him, repent of all your sins, confess Him, and be baptized. Don't put it off. Be baptized today!
