If the will of God was done on earth as it is in heaven, what would? Today we're
going to explore theof God's will being done on earth. When people do God's
will, they wisely and find blessing. Read what Solomon proclaimed in Proverbs 2:2-5.
We must search out God's will and it; only then can we be the people that God
intended.
Jesus taught us to pray, "Your be done on earth, as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10).
I encourage you to that with me. Pray "Your will be done"; pray it every day. Pray it
fervently, repeatedly, and confidently. Let's call upon God to His will in our own
lives, in our homes, in our communities, and in our nation. Should the Lord's will be done on

They wouldn't build their own denominations or organizations and vote on what they they believe as if they could overrule Jesus Christ. Rather they would acknowledge Psalm 119:89, which says, "Forever, O Lord, Your is settled in heaven." They wouldn't give themselves exalted religious but would focus on Jesus Christ.
If people really decided to obey God's revealed will, they'd follow the one and only Galatians 1:6-9 says there's only one gospel. They'd understand that the grace of God works through the gospel so they wouldn't invent ways to be saved or ignore what God requires for salvation. When I hear some folks talk the way they do, it's clear they haven't studied the of God as it's revealed in Scripture. They assume from movies and popular that they know God. They think God will them to believe or to do anything that they and God will never judge them or hold them accountable for it. Some have a view that God is like a benevolent but isolated and benign old grandfather who what they do but gives them his love and blessing no matter what. The devil steps in with and counterfeits to people and lead them into error and ultimately into condemnation. Here are some lies that the devil's ways.
Some think God is too to punish anyone for sin. They think because God is gracious to that He'll forgive even the evildoers. They forget the Lord God
has a track record of evil. Read 2 Peter 2:4-10 . If God punished the angels, the ancient world, and the ungodly cities, He'll punish on the last day.
If we take God lightly or ignore His warnings, we only bring on ourselves. God the truth clearly and with finality. He doesn't His commandments or His warnings. What God said in the Scriptures in the first century is just as
today as it was when the Holy Spirit moved men to write. Numbers 23:19 says, "God is not man, that he should, or a son of man, that he should his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?" What Jesus called sin in the first century is sin today. Nothing has Do not be deceived!

By grace God saves us in and through baptism.
In the sixteenth century men began teaching the sovereignty of God, and what that meant was that people could not choose whether to the Lord. They thought they were in sin and couldn't change, that God had to change them miraculously. They also taught salvation by grace meant that one couldn't be saved by and they believed that was a work and so it didn't save. Unfortunately, they misunderstood many things. First, man does indeed have and can change. This is why God, in every age, has
called men to Repentance is a change of leading to a change of ways. Why would God us to repent, knowing that we didn't have that ability, and then condemn us for not repenting? Do not be deceived!
Second, baptism is God works on us. Read Colossians 2:12-13 . This passage clearly states that God us in baptism, raises us up in baptism, and forgives our in baptism. God is the one and we receive His action by being baptized. To say baptism is unnecessary for salvation is to refuse to let God in our lives.
The notion that we are saved by faith is, but it's not the truth. According to the Scriptures, there are factors that are essential to our salvation. We can't segregate one to the exclusion of all the others. Understanding the whole truth

means that we understand that the Bible says on a subject rather than separating out only one factor. This is why salvation by faith is true, but salvation by faith is false.
The Scripture many things are involved in our salvation. Titus 3:5 says we are saved "by the of regeneration and the renewing of the Holy Spirit." That's a reference to Romans 1:16 says the gospel is "the of God unto salvation." Acts 2:38 says " and be in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins." First Peter 3:21 says "baptism now you." Acts 22:16 says "be baptized, and your sins, calling on His name." Hebrews 5:9 says Jesus is "the source of eternal salvation to all who him." Romans 6:3-7 says that when we're baptized into Christ we are baptized into His death, buried with Him, and raised with Him to walk in of life. That's when we're again. In baptism we're crucified with Christ so that our body of might be done away with. It's clear from these verses and many other Scriptures that faith is not the necessary factor in being saved by the Lord Jesus. Do not be deceived!
