The Scriptures show kindness, teach the saving, help the poor, care for the children, and the young to live Godly and spiritual lives. 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| Our English word "church" is the normal for a Greek term <i>ekklesia</i> . The word <i>ekklesia</i> literally means "called out" and refers to an assembly or a congregation that's been called together for a The church is made up of the Lord's people called out from the, disciples who have denied themselves and taken up their crosses to follow Him. The church consists of those who have been washed in the of Jesus Christ. When a person is baptized for the forgiveness of his sins, the Lord him to the church, His body. So, the church is made up of the saved who their lives in service to the Lord. |

| Paul said, "Him (speaking about Jesus) we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature (or complete) in Christ" (Colossians 1:28). When people mature in their faith and in their knowledge of Jesus, they can the trickery and lies of the devil. The apostle Paul explains the value of this maturity; he wants us to be mature "so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes" (Ephesians 4:14). 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| When we mature spiritually, we'll be to distinguish the good from the evil, the true from the false, and right from wrong. | As a body, we are called to and to serve the Lord. The Lord wants us to offer up spiritual that God can accept (1 Peter 2:5). He wants us to worship as people devoted to the Lord with our hearts, those hearts that are before God. In the church that Jesus built everyone is a priest and everyone has a responsibility to worship and serve God. |
| When the church assembled together they sang hymns; they communed in the Lord's Supper; they prayed; they collected money to support the works of the church; and they listened to the preaching of the Word. Paul's epistle to the Colossians was designed to be to the assembled congregation or church (Colossians 4:16). Paul said, "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and |

| hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God" (Colossians 3:16). |

Doctrine Matters Galatians 1:6-9

| You've probably heard the old saying, "It doesn't matter what you believe as long as you're" Is that true? Today we will see what we believe matters. The Lord Jesus what He had to say very, very highly. Read Luke 9:26 . Jesus said that when He returns in glory He will be ashamed of those who are ashamed of His This seems to many today who don't think it matters what you believe, but the Lord Jesus takes what we believe very seriously. |
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| We live in a confused age that speaks of " truth" and " truth." Many today believe that all truth is and there are no absolute truths. In a postmodern society, truth isn't as as getting along with people. If you disagree with your friend's beliefs, today's version of love dictates that you must unconditionally their beliefs as an alternate version of the truth. Some assume if you with anyone about anything that you're mean-spirited. But is it loving to remain about the truth? Did Jesus remain silent about the truth? |
| Paul once asked, "So have I become your by telling you the truth?" (Galatians 4:16). Paul knew the truth was to have a right relationship with God and that a lie would cause them to be lost. Because he loved them, he wanted them to know the truth that would them, rather than believe a lie that would them. Doctrine matters because the matters. | The word doctrine simply means Many who don't like "doctrine" nevertheless want teaching from God. Here are some reasons why doctrine or teaching is very, very important. | Some religious groups constant messages on positive mental attitudes and |

| teachers who preach what people to hear. As Paul predicted in 2 Timothy 4:4, they |
| have bought into myths and turned their away from the truth. Many have chosen to |
| live as idolaters who design their God rather than follow the God of the Bible. If we |
| don't know the doctrine of the Bible, we cannotthe Lord Jesus. |
| Second, doctrine is utterly to Christians. Read what Paul told Timothy of |
| the value of Scripture in 2 Timothy 3:15-17. Scripture gives us the foundational teaching that |
| we need to God. It reproves us when we're deceived or sinful, so that we may |
| ourselves. Then God's Word works in our lives to us out of ignorance |
| and sin into the truth and into righteousness. The inspired Word also us for |
| righteousness; it teaches us how to do every good work. God can transform our lives and turn |
| us into people who everyone around us if we'll let Him, but we have to let Him. |
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| Third, Jesus taught doctrine because He wanted us to the truth. If we believe Jesus |
| is the resurrected Son of God, and He is, what He teaches is To deny His doctrine or |
| teaching is really to deny We can't Christ from His teaching. Jesus |
| once asked, "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?" (Luke 6:46). If we |
| want to go to heaven, then we follow the teaching of Jesus. |
| Doctrine is necessary to know the truth and to distinguish the truth from The world |
| is about the truth. Some think that there's no such thing as absolute truth; and |
| others believe that each person can manufacture his own of the truth. The Lord |
| Jesus made two important statements about the truth in The Gospel According to John. First, |

| truth to us. If we truly wish to know the truth, then we must to Jesus. Second, He |

| told those Jews who believed in Him, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free" (John 8:31-32). It's only by abiding in the words of Jesus that we can know the truth, and only by abiding in His words can we truly be His disciples, and only by abiding in His words can we truly be! |
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| When people to know the truth in God's Word, the Bible, they easily fall for teaching. The best way to ourselves from lies, myths, and falsehoods comes from knowing the Scripture. It's noble to examine the teaching that we hear, to examine it very closely, and then to it with what the Bible says (Acts 17:11). The Bereans listened intelligently; they didn't simply swallow whatever Paul They him out. God considers it to examine, to evaluate, and to distinguish the truth from error, the right from wrong, and the Biblical from the human. Read 1 John 4:1 . |
| The chief priests and the scribes challenged Jesus often while He was teaching, and they wanted Him to the question, "By what authority are You doing these things, and who gave You this authority?" Jesus responded, "I also will ask you one question, and if you tell me the answer, then I also will tell you by what authority I do these things. The baptism of John, from where did it come? From heaven or from man?" Matthew 21:24-25. That's a great question to ask about any doctrine or practice. Does it come from or from? Many religions are filled with doctrines and practices that are in origin. Christ never taught these doctrines or instructed His people to these things. What some people Christian is actually foreign to Christ, but people don't know it because they've never taken time to their beliefs and practices in the Scriptures. Just because some church believes something or practices something doesn't mean that it came from |

When people judging anything as right or wrong, they irresistibly start permitting what is wrong to their lives.
